- ➡ The hope of living forever makes it worthwhile for Christians to live God's way now, even if it makes life hard for them. If there were just one life, they should just have fun with it. Sin matters because it has eternal consequences.
- ➡ The Bible says that Jesus's death and resurrection are the most important things about the Christian faith. They do not worship a dead God - Jesus is alive.
- ➡ Jesus's resurrection is what gives Christians hope. Because he is alive, they can look forward to life with him. If he were dead, they would be wasting their time.
